Hörmann Door Models - Courses

Basic Course 101

The 101 course is a one-day course experience designed to teach the basics of mechanical installation, electrical connections and troubleshooting with a focus on service. This course is primarily in a classroom setting with some hands-on. A factory tour is included. A Certificate of Achievement is received upon completion.

Advanced Course 201 - Speed-Guardian™ Focus

The 201 course is an experience designed for individuals who have completed the Basic course and have a good knowledge base installing high speed doors as well as experience with electrical schematics. This course includes some classroom training but focuses on hands-on training installing a Speed-Guardian door. In depth teaching of both mechanical and electrical installation of the Speed-Guardian™ models is targeted. A factory tour is included. A Certificate of Achievement is received upon completion.

TNR Door Model - Courses

Day 1 Course - ChillFast Freezer Door

The Day 1 course is hands-on installation of the ChillFast Freezer door including mechanical installation and electrical connections. Students will be expected to demonstrate the following: how to find the deviation in the floor from one jamb to the other; starting up the door including setting the full open and full close limits; how to view and clear the fault history on the control panel; how to view the operating conditions of the motor and control panel. A Certificate of Achievement is received upon completion.

Day 2 Course - New Generation HDR Rubber Door (Available starting with the May 15 course date)

The Day 2 course is hands-on installation of the new generation HDR rubber door including mechanical installation and electrical connections. Students will be expected to demonstrate the following: how to find the deviation in the floor from one jamb to the other; starting up the door including setting the full open and full close limits; how to view and clear the fault history on the control panel; how to view the operating conditions of the motor and control panel. A Certificate of Achievement is received upon completion.
